Space is limited; registration will be open to the public on March 16.



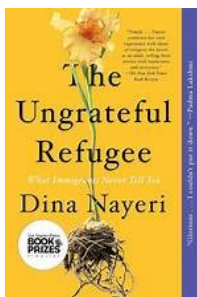
